Mahabalipuram, derived from 'Mamallapuram' is a town in Kancheepuram district in the Indian state of Tamil Nadu. Mahabalipuram was a 7th century [port city](#) of the South Indian dynasty of the Pallavas around 60 km south from the city of Chennai in Tamil Nadu. The name Mamallapuram is believed to have been given after the Pallava king Narasimhavarman I, who took on the epithet Maha-malla (great wrestler), as the favourite sport of the Pallavas was wrestling. It has various historic monuments built largely between the 7th and the 9th centuries, and has been classified as a [UNESCO World Heritage Site](#).

Puducherry, formerly known as **Pondicherry**, is a Union Territory of India. It is a former French colony, consisting of four non-contiguous enclaves, or regions, and named after the largest region, Pondicherry. The territory was officially known as Pondicherry until 2006 when it was renamed Puducherry.

Thanjavur, also known as **Thanjai** or by its anglicised name Tanjore. The name Thanjavur is derived from "Tanjan", a legendary asura in Hindu mythology. Thanjavur is one of the oldest cities in India and has a long and varied history dating back to Sangam period. The city rose into prominence during the rule of the Later Cholas when it served as the capital of the Chola empire. After the fall of the Cholas, the city was ruled by the Pandyas, Vijayanagar Empire, the Madurai Nayaks, the Thanjavur Nayaks, the Thanjavur Marathas and the British.





Thanjavur is an important center of South Indian art and architecture. Most of the Great Living Chola Temples, an UNESCO [World Heritage](#) Monument are located in an around Thanjavur. The foremost among the Great Living Chola temples, the Brihadeeswara Temple, is located in the center of the city. Thanjavur is also the home of the [Tanjore painting](#), a painting style unique to the region. The city is an important agricultural center located at the heart of the region, known as the "rice bowl of Tamil Nadu". South Zone Culture Centre in Thanjavur is one of many regional cultural centres established by Indian Government to preserve and promote traditional cultural heritage of India.






Madurai, formerly **Madura** is among the oldest continuously inhabited city in the Indian peninsula. It is an ancient and prestigious city in the Indian state of Tamil Nadu, situated on the banks of the River Vaigai in Madurai district.

The city is widely known as the Temple City, and is often also referred to as City of four

junctions (*Koodal Maanagar*), Cultural center of Tamil Nadu (*Kalaachaara thalainagar*), City of Jasmine (*Malligai Maanagar*), Sleepless city (*Thoonga Nagaram*), Athens of the East and The City of Festivals (*Thiruvizha nagaram*).

Madurai was the capital city of ancient Southern civilization. Madurai's cultural heritage goes back 2,500 years, and the city has been an important commercial center and has conducted trade as far as Rome and Greece since as early as 550 B.C.E.

Transfer to the hotel. 12:30 hrs: Lunch in the hotel. 14:30 hrs: Visit Brihadeshwara Temple, the world's first complete granite temple. Built in the 11th century, the 66 meters in height, it is the most marvelous architecture of it's time. Brihadeshwara is a gigantic lingam cut in a monolithic rock is about 8.7mtrs height. There is a huge Nandi within the vicinity of the temple. It is the second largest monolithic Nandi in the country. It also houses numbers of unique architectural wonders like the stone atop the temple - this huge tower weighs about 80 tonnes and it has baffled architects how this stone could have been lifted up when no machinery was available. It is believed that a ramp was built from a village 7 km away and this stone was pulled to the top by elephants. Situated on the banks of river Vaigai, Madurai has a rich cultural heritage passed on from the great Tamil era more than 2500 years old. Madurai was an important cultural and commercial centre even as early as 550 AD. Transfer to the hotel.</p> <p>12:30 hrs: Lunch in the hotel.</p> <p>14:30 hrs: Visit Madurai Temple, the largest temple complex of it's time. <p>The complex is in around 45 acres (180,000 m2) and the temple is a massive structure measuring 254 by 237 meters.
